Applicants who have attended international universities/colleges may have their course work considered for college prerequisites. In order to have these courses considered, applicants must complete a transcript evaluation by an approved member of the NACES agency. We have provided two agencies below, but a full list of acceptable member agencies can be found at [www.naces.org](http://www.naces.org).

Each student must provide proof of approval and the transcript must show all course information as outlined below:

**The transcript evaluation must show the following:**

- U.S. course equivalent for each course
- U.S. semester hour equivalent for each course
- U.S. grade equivalence for each course
- Calculated grade point average (if available)
