

## Continuing Education Course Description

### **MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING (MRI):**

The total length of the Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) course is 24 weeks. This will include both classroom and clinical components. The class will meet bi-weekly (12 times) on Thursday nights from 5:30p – 7:30p. This course is hybrid, to include both in person instruction as well as online via zoom. Clinical time is offered days, evenings and weekends and may vary depending on the clinical site. **There is a minimum requirement to complete 24 hours of clinical time per week.** Clinical experience is geared to provide an opportunity to earn competencies for the ARRT advanced modality certification. There is **no guarantee** of completion of all ARRT requirements. Competency completion is heavily dependent upon clinical volume and intern motivation. The course is designed to instruct technologists on theory and processes used in MRI. Applicants are required to have completed a cross-sectional anatomy course prior to the MRI course. Course space is limited. There are **no clinical only** options available.

- Successful completion of cross-sectional anatomy course
- RT(R) by ARRT, ARDMS, or NMTCB certification

### **Costs:**

- Application Fee: \$20.00
- Total Course Fee: \$2000.00 (class and clinical)
  - Classroom component: \$600.00 (classroom only is available)
  - Clinic component: \$1400.00 (clinic only is **not** available)
- Book: ~ \$60.00 (estimate)
- Uniform: ~\$120.00 (estimate) \*Must wear black scrub uniform (any brand) in clinic with ID badge at all times
- Background Check: \$62.00
- Health Screening: \$65.00 fee to School approved vendor for compliance tracking and drug screen
