I hope this message finds you and your loved ones well during this challenging time. As we reconvene the spring semester, I would like to share the following information with you regarding your courses:

- As previously communicated, all didactic courses will be taught online. Please review the updated course syllabus and calendar in the “COVID-19” tab on the left navigation sidebar in each of your courses in Blackboard.
- Bon Secours has determined that students will not be allowed in their facilities for clinical learning until May 31, 2020.
- School administration is working closely with our accreditors to ensure all students’ competency requirements are met. As of right now, the ARRT and the JRCERT have not issued any waivers to their clinical competency requirements. We are working to determine the best plan to ensure you have the opportunity to meet these requirements without it adversely impacting the expected date of program completion. Understanding that the COVID-19 situation is dynamic, plans must remain open to change. If there are any major adjustments to the program schedule, you will be notified in a timely manner.
- The summer outreach trip (RAM) is now cancelled. This decision was not taken lightly and we are saddened that we will not be able to offer this opportunity this summer.

Any curricular changes are in compliance with the stated regulatory waivers declared by the accreditation agencies and the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia. We appreciate your flexibility in these unprecedented times, and would like to reiterate that you should contact your faculty and/or advisor for any questions you may have.
