- I. Policy:
It is the policy of Bon Secours St. Mary's Hospital School of Medical Imaging (SOMI) to require students to check patient identification.

- II. Purpose:
The purpose of this policy is to outline the process for proper patient identification.

- III. Scope:
This policy applies to all SOMI students.

- IV. Policy Details:
All students are required to check a patient's arm band and ask patients to verbally state their name and date of birth. Patient identification must be verbally confirmed using the two-identifier system prior to radiation exposure.

If a patient is unable to state their name and date of birth, patient identification must be verified by either a nurse, parent/legal guardian, or a medical record accompanying the patient that matches patient's arm band.

Students are required to follow the patient identification procedures established by the clinical affiliate sites.

Students that do not follow proper procedures will be subject to disciplinary action.
